Rules & Guidelines:

- Exceeding the time limit will lead to a deduction of marks.
- Participants must speak either for or against the motion as allotted.
- The use of facts, examples, and clarity of ideas is encouraged.
- Participants are expected to maintain discipline and decorum.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- Content & Relevance
- Expression & Fluency
- Confidence & Body Language
- Use of Facts/Examples
- Adherence to Time
